## WELCOME TO YARINGA BOAT HARBOUR

Yaringa Boat Harbour is the perfect location for exploring the waters of Western Port Bay and beyond, set in a peaceful and natural environment only 1 hour from Melbourne. The Yaringa Boat Harbour precinct, covering approximately 20 hectares, is a vibrant working harbour that includes the following facilities:

- Boat harbour with 150 wet berths
- Storage for 300 trailable boats offering a launch & retrieval service every day
- Hard stand area for 200 boats with power & water supply
- Full slipping services catering for boats to 70 tonnes and catamarans to 8.6m in width.
- Storage containers for rent
- Marine services including Marine Mechanics, Mast & Rigging trades, Marine Covers, Boat Builders & Boat repairs, Sail Makers, Fiberglass moulding & manufacturing, Windscreen manufacturing & repair.
- The Chandlery offering bait, ice, all things marine, coffee and refreshments.
- Cptn Jack's Restaurant
- Jack's Green
- Yaringa Fishing Club
- Yaringa Yacht Club

### HARBOUR OFFICE

8:30am to 4:30pm, 7 days a week (excluding Christmas Eve & Christmas Day).

The Harbour Office is open daily should you require assistance or guidance on any aspect of the harbour precinct.

### DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Due to the protection of native wildlife, domestic animals or pets are not permitted within Yaringa Boat Harbour.

### POLLUTION

Yaringa Boat Harbour operates on a no discharge policy.

### VISITORS

Visitors must be accompanied by the boat owner.

Persons unaccompanied by the boat owner will not be allowed access to the harbour.

### CONTRACTORS

No contractor is to work within the harbour precinct (including 1, 2 & 3 Lumeah Road) without prior approval from harbour management, regardless if accompanied by boat owner or not.

Contractors Guidelines are to be filled out and signed prior to entrance.

### SPEED LIMIT

Speed limit in the Yaringa channel and harbour is 5kmh.

While travelling in the harbour, please travel at a speed that causes no wake.

In the carpark and boatyard please drive at 5kmh.

### AFTER HOURS / EMERGENCY CONTACT

For urgent assistance after hours please phone harbour manager whose number is located in the window near the office entrance. For all emergencies call "000".

### AMENITIES

Toilet and shower facilities are provided for your convenience next to the harbour office.

## **CAR PARK**

Car parking is provided for the use of all Yaringa customers and general public, however main gates are closed from restaurant close until 6am daily, with entry/ exit after hours only by security access pass.

## **EFTPOS**

The harbour office accepts EFTPOS, Visa and MasterCard. There is no "cash out" facility available. The nearest banks and ATM's are located in Somerville, Pearcedale or Hastings.

## **FUEL**

The fuel dock is located on the southern side of the boat ramp, opposite the restaurant, providing unleaded and diesel fuels. Fueling is only by marina staff during office hours. Please call or radio harbour office prior to approaching fuel dock.

## **GAS BOTTLES**

Swap 'n' Go gas bottles are available for exchange or purchase at the harbour office.

## **LAUNDRY**

Coin laundry facilities are provided for your convenience next to the harbour office. \$1 coins only.

## **MOORING BUOYS**

There are two swing moorings in Watson's Inlet that are provided for our customers and can accommodate boats up to 10m on one and 25m on the other. Both are rated and approved. Please call the Harbour Office prior if you wish to use it overnight, or if the use is in-conjunction with slipping services.

## **ON-SITE BUSINESSES**

A range of marine and retail businesses are located on-site at Yaringa including: Licensed Restaurant, The Chandlery, Cover and upholstery makers/repairs, Marine mechanics, Fiberglass repairers, Sail maker and riggers. A business directory is available at the harbour office or on our website.

## **PAY PHONE**

A payphone is located 100m from the main harbour entrance outside the Western Port Harbour Caravan Park.

## **Wi-Fi ACCESS**

The harbour has guest WiFi access available. You can visit the office for the access password.

## **PROVISIONS AND SHOPPING**

Cold drinks and light snacks are available at the vending machine located at the harbour office or via the Chandlery. Supermarkets, hardware stores, petrol stations and other shops are available at either Somerville (8km), Pearcedale (9km) or Hastings (12km) from Yaringa.

## **RADIO**

The harbour office monitors VHF channel 16 8.30am to 5pm daily, however if we are unable to respond, please phone the harbour office on (03) 5977 4154 or leave a message on the answering service.

## **THE CHANDLERY**

The Chandlery provides a wide range of stock for boat repairs and maintenance, bait, fishing tackle and ice. Coffee and other refreshments are available 7 days a week from 7am to 3.30pm.

## **RESTAURANT**

Cptn Jack's is fully licensed and open for both lunch and dinner. The restaurant is also available for functions. For reservations or opening times phone: (03) 5977 4939

## **TOURIST INFORMATION**

Information and maps on local attractions, dining or accommodation on the Mornington Peninsula and surrounds are available at the harbour office.

## **WEATHER FORECASTS**

### **YARINGA MARINE NATIONAL PARK**

### **FISHING**

Fishing in the area is excellent with many varieties caught in the area, including Snapper, Whiting, Gummy Shark, Squid, Mulloway, Flathead & for those venturing out into Bass Strait, Tuna & King Fish. Speak to our Harbour Office team for more information and local knowledge on your arrival.

### **MARINE PARK**

Yaringa Harbour is situated adjacent to the Yaringa Marine Park which is on the Northern boundary of the marina entrance.

### **LOCAL FLORA AND FAUNA**

The harbour precinct is home to a number of Australian native fauna & flora, including koalas, wallabies, echidnas, certain reptiles and birdlife.
